Day 1

Step 1: Meeting
The Assistant Principal
holds an initial meeting
with the student.

Step 2: Wellness Check
The School Nurse will
check the wellness of the
student before sending
them home.

Step 3: Police Involvement If there are substances or paraphernalia, the School Resource Officer will take item(s). Step 4: Parent
Notification
Parent or guardian will
be called to pick up the
student.

Day 2

Step 1: Assessment
Social worker will conduct
a behavioral health
assessment with the
student.

Step 2: In-School
Suspension
The student goes to inschool suspension for at least 1 day.

Step 3: Response Plan Meeting
Student, parents, Social Worker, and
Assistant Principal will meet and make a
plan for the student to be held
accountable for their actions, repair harm,
and be supported to return to school.

Days 3-8

Step 1: Response Plan
Completed
Student completes all
parts of the response plan.

Within 2 Weeks Step 1: Restorative Re-entry Meeting
Student, parents, Social Worker, Assistant
Principal, and Restorative Coordinator
meet to talk about the completed
response plan, repair harm, and support
student to not repeat the behavior.
